WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Culbertson, Roosevelt County, Montana has deemed it necessary to raise money by taxation in excess of the levy now allowed by law for general municipal and administrative purposes during the year 1935, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Culbertson, Roosevelt County, Montana, at the regular annual election held in such town of Culbertson on March 4, 1935, did submit the question of such additional levy to the voters of said Town who are tax-paying free holders therein and said Council was, by a majority of said tax-paying voters voting thereon, authorized to increase the levy for general municipal and administrative purposes from fifteen to twenty mills on each dollar of taxable property within said town of Culbertson,-

A RESOLUTION FIXING THE TAX LEVY FOR SINKING FUND PURPOSES FOR THE TOWN OF CULBERTSON, ROOSEVELT COUNTY, MONTANA TO MEET OBLIGATIONS DUE AND TO BECOME DUE DURING THE YEAR 1935.

WHEREAS the revenues from the Municipal Water Works of the Town of Culbertson, Roosevelt County, Montana, are inadequate to pay the interest and indebtedness on said plant and it is necessary to create a Sinking Fund to retire the obligations of said Town known as the REFUNDED WATER BONDS, and interest thereon, that a special tax be levied and fixed,-

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CULBERTS:

Section 1. That a tax of twenty-nine mills on the taxable property of the Town of Culbertson, Roosevelt County, Montana, is hereby fixed, assessed and levied for the year 1935, on each dollar taxable property within the limits of said town of Culbertson.

Section 2. That the amount of said tax when collected shall be used for the purpose of creating a Sinking Fund to retire the bonds known as REFUNDED WATER BONDS and the interest thereon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CULBERTSON:

Section 1. That a tax of fifteen mills on the taxable property of the Town of Culbertson, Montana, is hereby affixed and assessed and levied for the year 1935 on each dollar of taxable property within the limits of said town of Culbertson.

Section 2. That the amount of said tax when collected shall be used for the purpose of creating a Sinking Fund to retire the bond known as the FUNDED DEBT of the town of Culbertson, and the interest thereon.






