





RESOLUTION FIXING THE TAX LEVY FOR GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES
AND ADMINISTRATIVE PURPOSES FOR THE TOWN OF CULBERTSON?

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Culbertson, Roosevelt County, Montana, has deemed it necessary to raise money by taxation in excess of the levy now allowed by law for general municipal and administrative purposes during the year 1938, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Culbertson, Roosevelt County, Montana at the regular annual election held in such town of Culbertson on April 5, 1937, did submit the question of such additional levy to the voters of said Town who are tax-paying free holders therein and said Council was by a majority of said tax paying voters voting thereon, authorize to increase the levy for general administrative and municipal purposes from fifteen to twenty mills on each dollar taxable property within the said Town of Culbertson,--

NOW Therefore be it resolved by the Council of the Town of Culbertson, Roosevelt County Montana, that the ~~XXXXXX~~ annual assessment and tax levy of taxes of the Town of Culbertson, Montana, for general administrative and municipal purposes for the year 1938 be and the same is hereby fixed, assessed and levied at twenty mills on each dollar of taxable property within the corporate limits of the Town of Culbertson, and when said amount is paid into the said Town Treasurer of said Town, same shall be apportioned and distributed to the general fund of said Town.

Section 2. That the amount of said tax when collected shall be used for the purpose of creating a Sinking Fund to retire bonds and the interest thereon known as the REFUNDED WATER WORKS BONDS.
