RESOLUTION NO 136

A RESOLUTION ENTITLED: " A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CULBERTSON, MONTANA, RATIFYING, APPROVING AND CONFIRMING THE ACTION OF THE CULBERTSON AIRPORT BOARD OF THE TOWN OF CULBERTSON, MONTANA, AND THE COUNTY OF ROOSEVELT, MONTANA, IN BORROWING FROM THE MONTANA AERONAUTICS COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF MONTANA, THE SUM OF \$18,100 FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECONSTRUCTING THE E/W RUNWAY, TAXIWAY AND APRON ON THE CULBERTSON AIRPORT AT CULBERTSON, MONTANA, AND OBLIGATING THE TOWN OF CULBERTSON MONTANA, TO REPAY SAID TOWN'S PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF SAID LOAN".

WHEREAS, said Town Council of the Town of Culbertson, Montana, and the County of Roosevelt, Montana, has applied to the Montana Aeronautics Commission of the State of Montana, for a loan of State funds in the amount of \$18,100 to be expended for reconstructing the E/W runway, taxiway and apron at Culbertson, Montana; and

WHEREAS, said Culbertson Airport Board of the Town of Culbertson, Montana, and County of Roosevelt, Montana, has passed and enacted a certain Resolution concerning said loan and prescribing the terms of repayment thereof, a copy of which said Resolution is annexed hereto, marked Exhibit "A", and hereby made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary, under the law, for the Town of Culbertson, Montana, by and through its regularly constituted Town Council to ratify, approve and confirm said Resolution attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for said Town of Culbertson, Montana, by and through its duly and regularly constituted Town Council to obligate itself to repay its proportionate share of said loan to be made from the Montana Aeronautics Commission;



NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Council  
of the Town of Culbertson, Montana;

1. That said Resolution hereto attached, marked Exhibit "A" of the  
Culbertson Airport Board of the Town of Culbertson, Montana, and the County  
of Roosevelt, Montana, is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved in all  
things.

2. That the Town of Culbertson, Montana, does hereby obligate  
itself to repay to the Montana Aeronautics Commission of the State of Montana,  
by and through the Culbertson Airport Board of the Town of Culbertson,  
Montana, and the County of Roosevelt, Montana, the sum of \$8,100 as its  
proportionate share of said loan during the period of time beginning with the  
1st day of December, 1965, and ending with the 1st day of December, 1974,  
and at the times set forth in Exhibit "A" hereto attached, and further, the  
Town of Culbertson, Montana, does hereby agree that it will make the  
necessary tax levy or levies to provide its said proportionate share of funds  
for the repayment of said loan and does obligate such funds so received,  
pursuant to said tax levy or levies, to the repayment of its said proportionate  
share of said loan, pursuant to the terms and conditions prescribed by the  
State of Montana by and through the Montana Aeronautics Commission, all as  
is set forth in Exhibit "A" hereto attached.

3. That the Town of Culbertson, Montana, will approve and provide  
a provision in the budget of the Culbertson Airport Board of the Town of  
Culbertson, Montana, and the County of Roosevelt, Montana, which will  
make available funds for repayment of said loan in the manner and form as  
herein and in Exhibit "A" set forth.

A RESOLUTION ENTITLED: "A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CULBERTSON, MONTANA, RATIFYING, APPROVING AND CONFIRMING THE ACTION OF THE CULBERTSON AIRPORT BOARD OF THE TOWN OF CULBERTSON, MONTANA, AND THE COUNTY OF ROOSEVELT, MONTANA, IN BORROWING FROM THE MONTANA AERONAUTICS COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF MONTANA, THE SUM OF \$21,000 FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECONSTRUCTING THE E/W RUNWAY, TAXIWAY AND APRON ON THE CULBERTSON AIRPORT AT CULBERTSON, MONTANA, AND OBLIGATING THE TOWN OF CULBERTSON, MONTANA, TO REPAY SAID TOWN'S PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF SAID LOAN".

WHEREAS, said Town Council of the Town of Culbertson, Montana, and the County of Roosevelt, Montana, has applied to the Montana Aeronautics Commission of the State of Montana, for a loan of State funds in the amount of \$21,000 to be expended for reconstructing the E/W runway, taxiway and apron at Culbertson, Montana; and

WHEREAS, said Culbertson Airport Board of the Town of Culbertson, Montana, and County of Roosevelt, Montana, has passed and enacted a certain Resolution concerning said loan and prescribing the terms of repayment thereof, a copy of which said Resolution is annexed hereto, marked Exhibit "A", and hereby made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary, under the law, for the Town of Culbertson, Montana, by and through its regularly constituted Town Council to ratify, approve and confirm said Resolution attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for said Town of Culbertson, Montana, by and through its duly and regularly constituted Town Council to obligate itself to repay its proportionate share of said loan to be made from the Montana Aeronautics Commission;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Council of the Town of Culbertson, Montana;

1. That said Resolution hereto attached, marked Exhibit "A" of the Culbertson Airport Board of the Town of Culbertson, Montana, and the County of Roosevelt, Montana, is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved in all things.

2. That the Town of Culbertson, Montana, does hereby obligate itself to repay to the Montana Aeronautics Commission of the State of Montana, by and through the Culbertson Airport Board of the Town of Culbertson, Montana, and the County of Roosevelt, Montana, the sum of \$11,000 as its proportionate share of said loan during the period of time beginning with the 1st day of December, 1965, and ending with the 1st day of December, 1974, and at the times set forth in Exhibit "A" hereto attached, and further, the Town of Culbertson, Montana, does hereby agree that it will make the necessary tax levy or levies to provide its said proportionate share of funds for the repayment of said loan and does obligate such funds so received, pursuant to said tax levy or levies, to the repayment of its said proportionate share of said loan, pursuant to the terms and conditions prescribed by the State of Montana by and through the Montana Aeronautics Commission, all as is set forth in Exhibit "A" hereto attached.

3. That the Town of Culbertson, Montana, will approve and provide a provision in the budget of the Culbertson Airport Board of the Town of Culbertson, Montana, and the County of Roosevelt, Montana, which will make available funds for repayment of said loan in the manner and form as herein and in Exhibit "A" set forth.
